




- One Table

- An Adequate Display Space
- Varying Display Heights
- Consumer Interest
- Professional look

What were my guidelines?

Costs- Let's be honest CHEAP!

Manageable for one person


EASY to put together

EASY to take down

FITS in my car

FLEXIBLE – pieces have to work together or separately





I used:

- Sturdy foldable tables Home Depot 2x4 2 pk
- Wooden Boxes GoodWill
- Trellis Lowes Garden Supply
- Inexpensive fabric JOAnns 60% off coupons
- Panels from my dog's portable kennel
- Use Plastic Bins for Transport AND Display Prop.
- Anything at home that could be used: plants, bowls, seasonal decorating items etc.
- I borrowed (or took) castoffs from friends or "found "objects (dumpster dived)

I modify things as necessary:



- Corner braces added to lattice for shelves
- Art bins covered in fabric for added height
- Wood box from Goodwill as riser, with pipe straps to mount vertical trellis on box
- •Add an additional table for more space if needed.
- Dog Kennel panels become art grids



Added:

- 1. Pipe Straps to box
- 2. Trellis inserted into pipe clamps
- 3. Shelving put on top of corner brackets

It's all interchangeable.

It all breaks down easily.


Removed:

- 1. One trellis
- 2. All shelving

Added:

- 1. Wreath
- 2. Two display boxes
- 3. 3 stepped boxes
- 4. 2 –Dog kennel panels as vertical grids
