Exhibit Submission Guidelines

These guidelines outline requirements for artists who wish to submit and exhibit work at the Dry Canyon Community Art Center **Grand Opening Exhibition**.

1. Guidelines for the Main Gallery

All art must be original. The Art Center cannot accept AI generated art.

2-D artists may submit up to three works, none of which may exceed 35 pounds and no larger than 24" x 24." Including the frame.

- Weight and size guidelines apply only to the Grand Opening to accommodate the maximum number of artists. Weight and size guidelines will change for future exhibitions.

2-D work must be wired to hang on the galley walls. All work must have ID Tags on the back with artist name, phone number, title of work, and price. See tip sheet for guidelines on hanging your art.

Unframed 2-D work must have finished edges. Unframed work may be on any substrate. Some examples are canvas, glass, wood, or cradle board.

3-D artists may submit up to three works.

3-D work that hangs must be wired to hang on the galley walls. All work must have ID Tags on the back with artist name, phone number, title of work, and price. Work cannot exceed 35 pounds and no larger than 24" x 24."

- Weight and size guidelines apply only to the Grand Opening to accommodate the maximum number of artists. Weight and size guidelines will change for future exhibitions.

3-D art that is to be installed on a pedestal and exceeds 30 pounds, or is awkward, and requires special handling will require the artist to assist in installation.

2. Guidelines for the Gift Gallery

All art must be original. The Art Center cannot accept AI generated art.

All pieces accepted must have an identifier on the bottom or back of the piece with the name/initials and the price.

All pieces submitted for gift gallery inclusion need to be for sale.

Artists may submit the following number of pieces for the categories listed. Artists can submit only five images, Images should be representative of the pieces being submitted. Not every piece needs to have an image.

- Fiber arts: 1 to 5 pieces **Up to 24" x 48"**
- Jewelry: up to 15 sets, individual pieces, or a combination of sets and individual pieces
- Ceramics: up to 10 pieces **Up to 18"**
- Glass Art: up to 10 pieces **Up to 14" less than 15lbs**
- 3-D sculptures: 1 to 5 pieces **Up to 14"**
- Small **3-D** pieces **Smaller than 10"**
- Greeting cards: maximum 30 greeting cards (in plastic sleeves).

Artwork to be shown in print bins: All pieces must be matted on foamcore or white board and be neatly wrapped in clear wrap (not home stretch film). Cardboard backing is not acceptable. It is acceptable to mount smaller pieces on larger foamcore for presentation.

- Unframed originals: 5 pieces max size **24" x 36" including mat**
- Giclee / Fine Art prints: 5 pieces max size **24" x 36" including mat**
